		TRIAL INFORMATION

COME NOW Tyler J. Buller and Thomas E. Bakke, Assistant Attorneys General, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Iowa accuse Defendants Eric Wood, Anthony "Tony" Snyder, and Aaron Alspach of committing the following crimes in Calhoun County, Iowa, in the following manner:

COUNT 1
Felonious Misconduct in Office
Class D Felony

Defendants Eric Wood, Anthony "Tony" Snyder, and Aaron Alspach, on or about October of 2020, while public officers or employees, did knowingly:

- a. make or give a false certificate, where such certificate was authorized by law;
- b. falsify a public record; or
- c. falsify a writing, or deliver a falsified writing, knowing that the writing is falsified and will become a public record of a government body,

in violation of Iowa Code section 721.1.

COUNT 2
Preventing Apprehension or Obstructing Prosecution
AGGRAVATED MISDEMEANOR

Defendant Eric Wood, between 2020 and 2022, prevented the apprehension or obstructed the prosecution of Aaron Alspach, Anthony "Tony" Snyder, or any other person, by knowingly destroying, altering, concealing, or disguising physical evidence

which would be admissible in the trial of another for a public offense, in violation of Iowa Code section 719.3.

COUNT 3
Suborning Perjury
CLASS D FELONY

Defendant Eric Wood, on or about October of 2020, suborned Anthony "Tony" Snyder to commit perjury in violation of Iowa Code section 720.3.

COUNT 4
Perjury
CLASS D FELONY

Defendants Eric Wood and Anthony "Tony" Snyder, on or about October of 2020, committed perjury by knowingly making a false statement of material fact under oath or affirmation, in violation of Iowa Code section 720.2.


COUNT 5
Suborning Perjury
CLASS D FELONY

Defendant Eric Wood, on or about October of 2020, suborned Aaron Alspach to commit perjury in violation of Iowa Code section 720.3.

COUNT 6
Perjury
CLASS D FELONY

Defendants Eric Wood and Aaron Alspach, on or about October of 2020, committed perjury by knowingly making a false statement of material fact under oath or affirmation, in a different document than Count 4, in violation of Iowa Code section 720.2.
